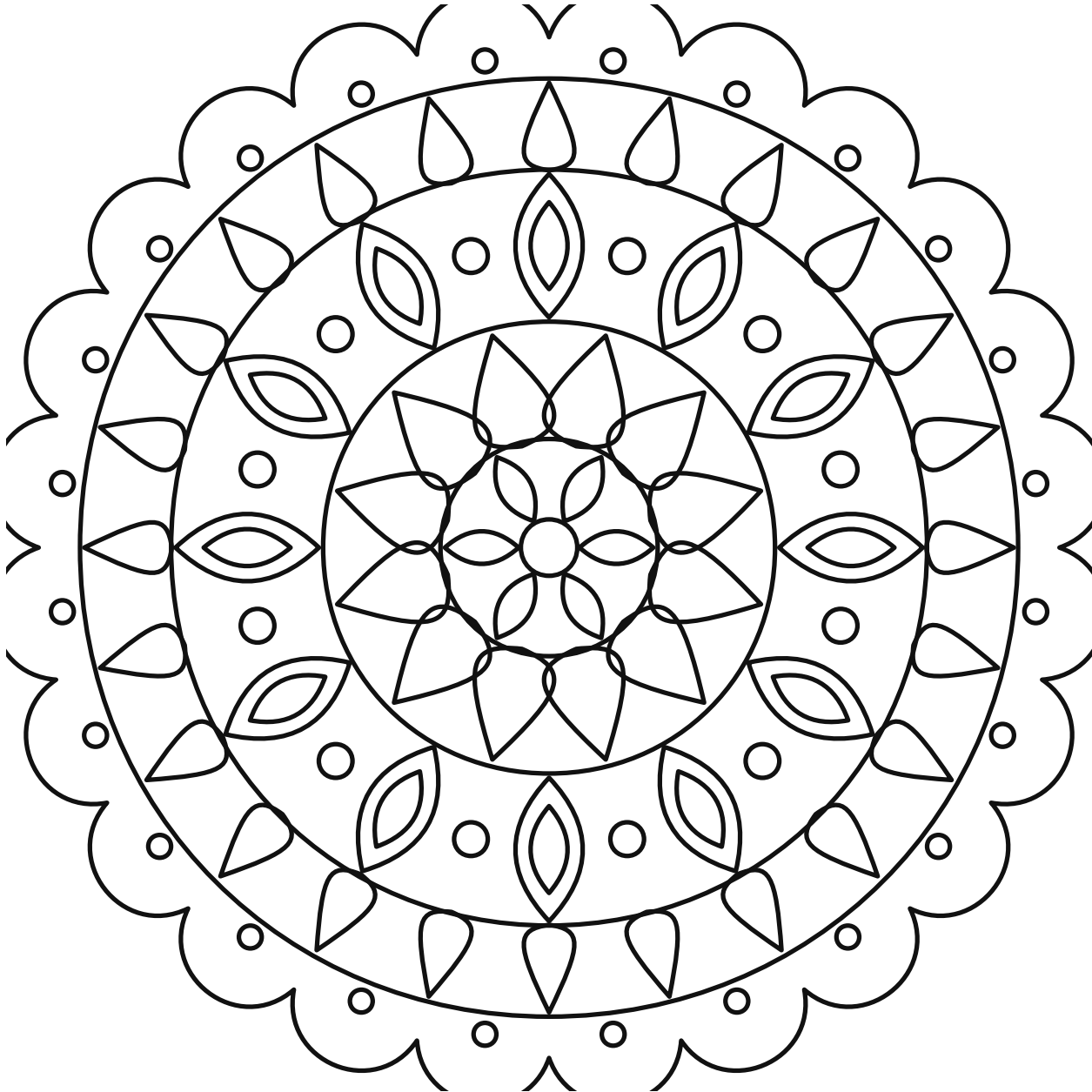


Diwali Rangoli

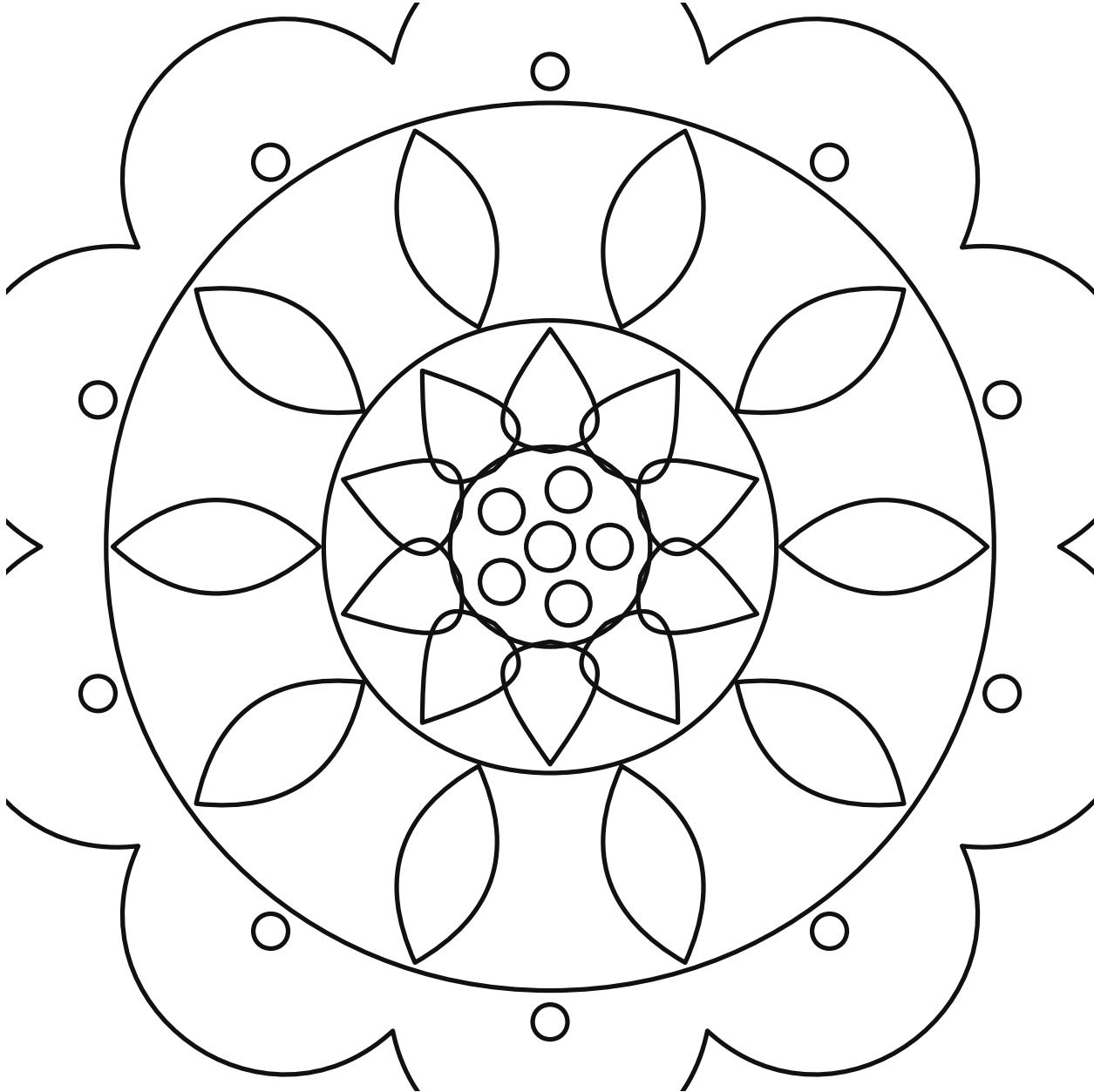

Directions: This rangoli has larger shapes, so it is a good choice for younger children. Try using the same color for every petal in a ring.

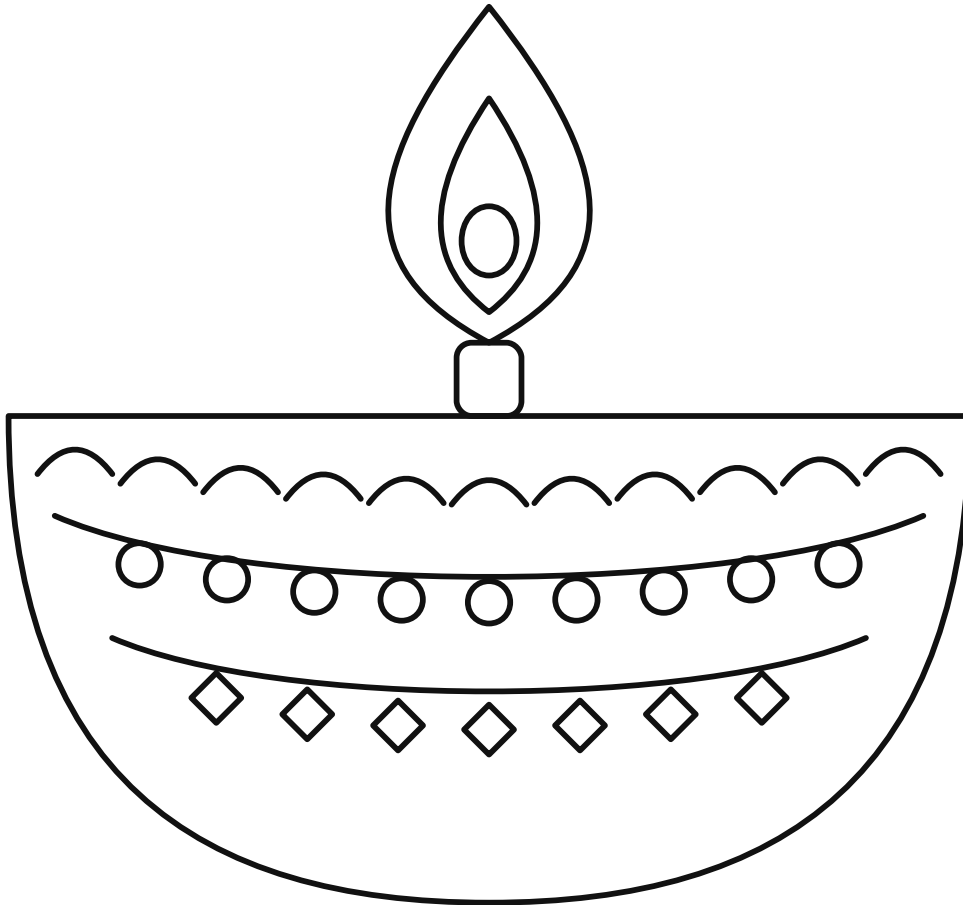

markers, crayons, colored pencils, paint, or oil pastels

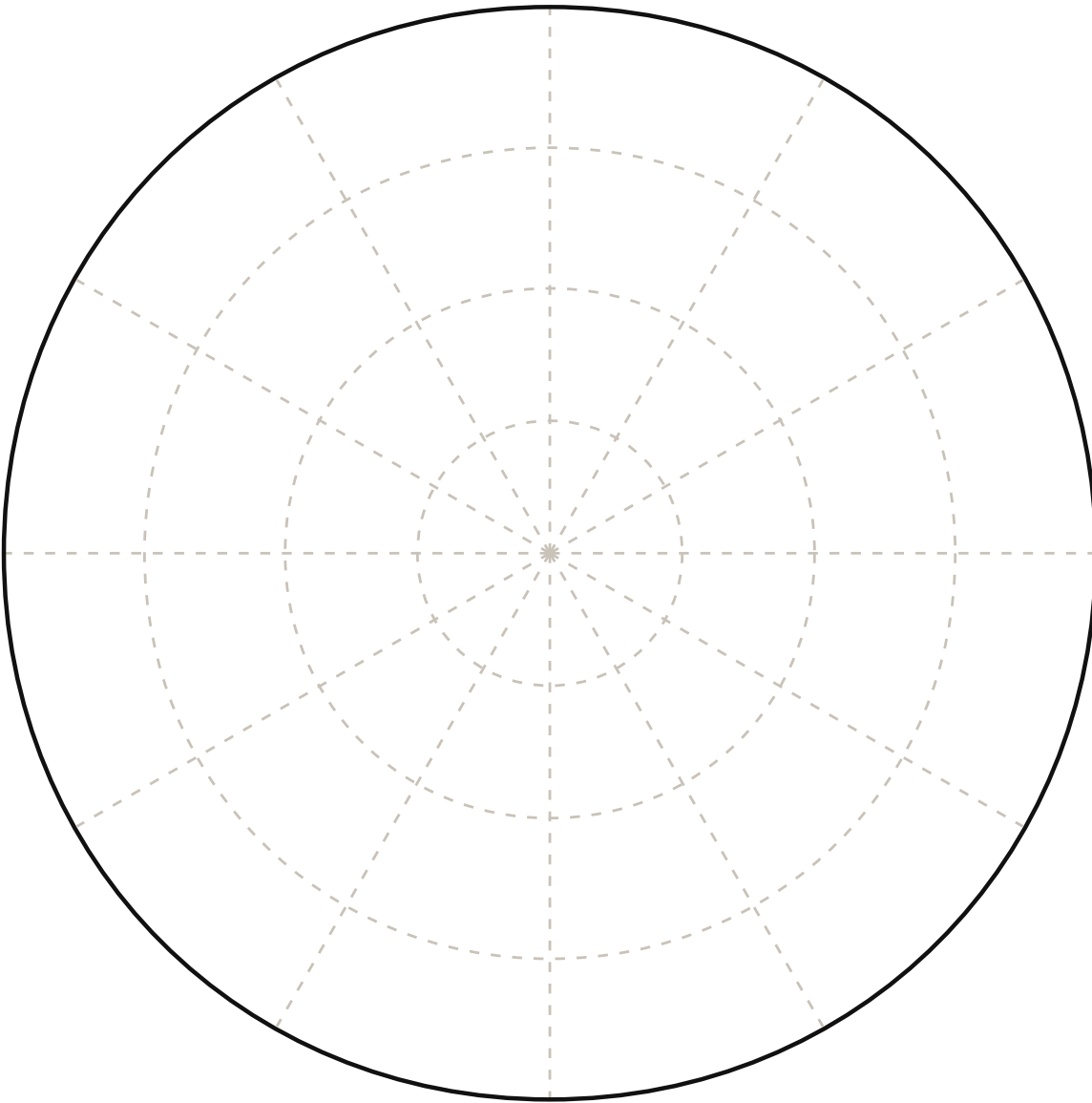
Or glue things on

rice, lentils, dried beans, glitter, sequins, stickers, buttons, torn paper, dry pasta, or flower petals

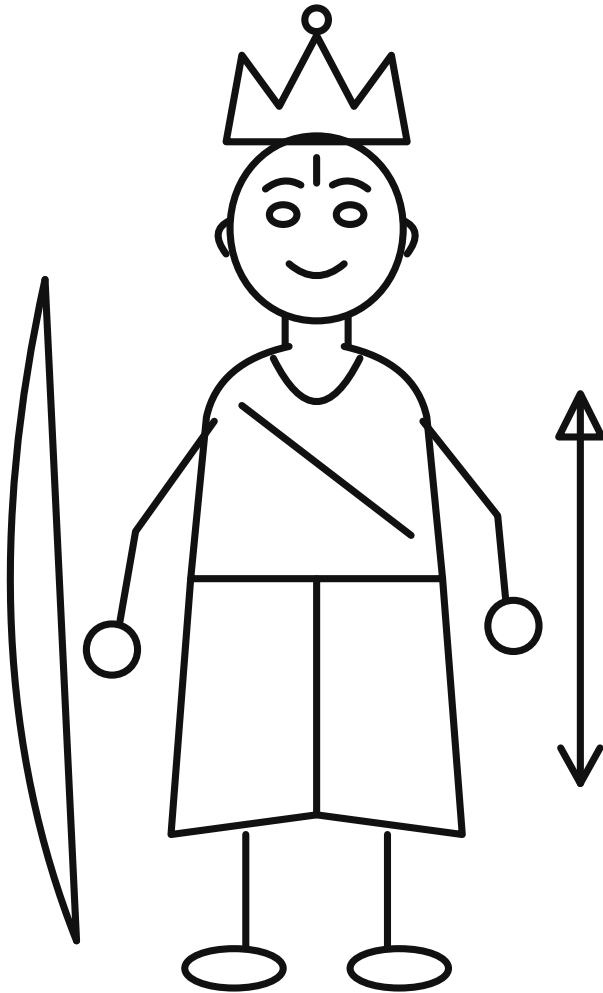
Design Your Own Rangoli

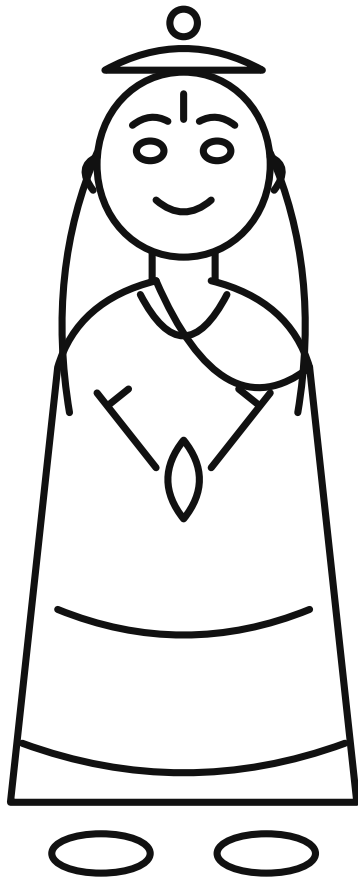


Directions: Color the picture. A prince who was sent away to the forest for fourteen years. He carries a bow.

Directions: Color the picture. Ram's wife. When Ravana carried her away, she dropped a trail of jewelry so she could be found.

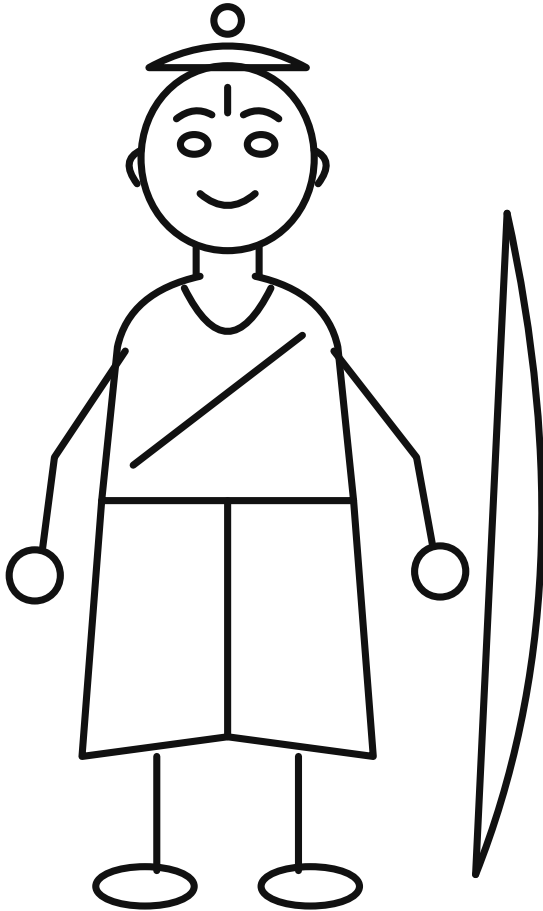




Lakshman

Directions: Color the picture. Ram's loyal brother. He went with Ram and Sita into the forest.

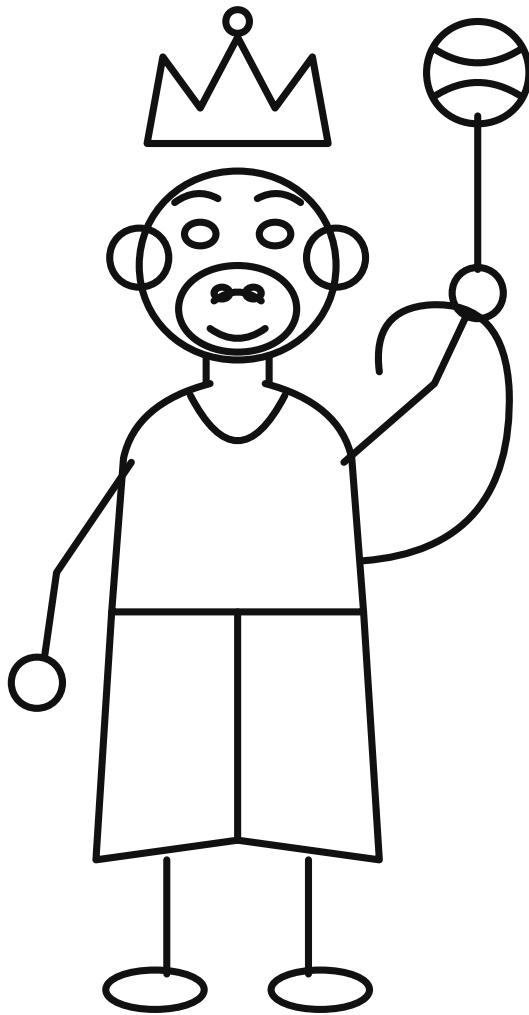

Directions: Color the picture. The flying monkey king. He found Sita on the island and his army built a bridge to reach her.

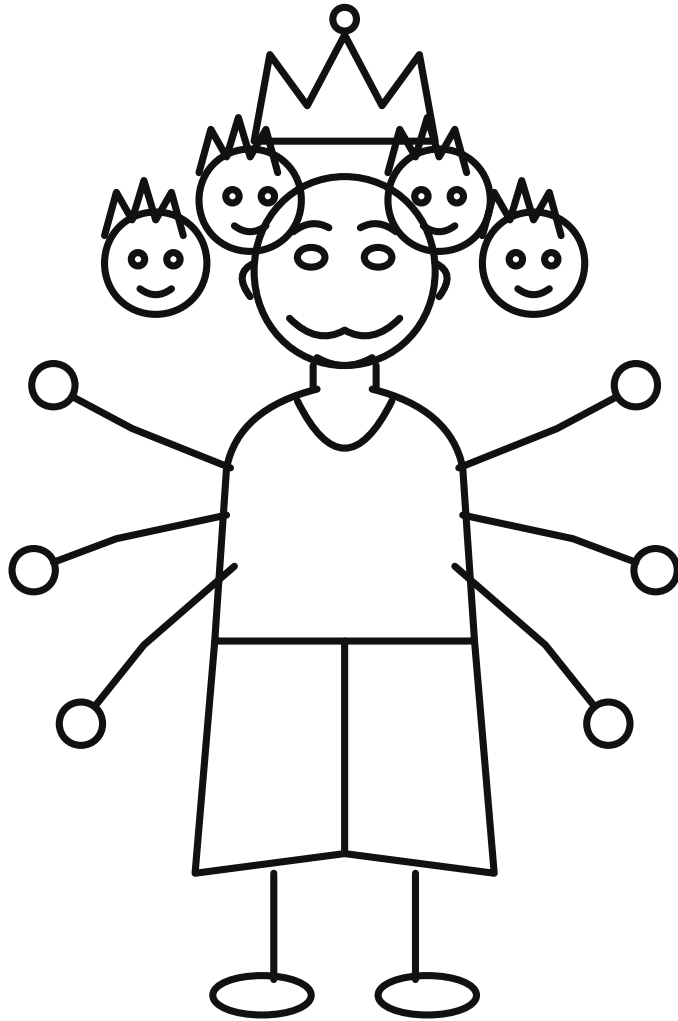
